

Welcome to BCRSP and TRTA! It's going to be a wonderful year! Your membership signifies your belief in our organization. TRTA is the only organization that focuses on your TRS retirement security. The annual membership fee you invest is money well spent. It keeps your organization strong, active, vocal and visible here in Texas and In Washington, DC!

Because of your membership in TRTA, the 98,000 member strong organization lobbied, wrote letters, visited the Capital, and stood strong in our

need for a COLA. The legislature heard us overwhelmingly. Because of your efforts, folks who have been retired and over 75 will receive \$7,500. Folks 70 and over will receive \$2,400! Plus, an increase in our pensions of either 2%, 4% or 6% will be forthcoming with the passage of Proposition 9 in November. This one is not a slam dunk but the money is



there, required no new tax, doesn't hurt our pension fund, BUT we must get our story out to the voters! None of this would have happened if it wasn't for TRTA.

But our organization stands for more than legislative action. We provide assistance for beginning educators, support members in need, finance school innovative projects, provide books for children, present scholarships to local graduating seniors, educate our membership of various community opportunities and provide information for personal growth and well-being.

Your board has worked throughout the summer to ensure that our meetings are meaningful and informative. It is our hope that you find your membership and meeting attendance of great value. I look forward to seeing you at our meetings!

And I hasten to add these legislators also firmly supported retired Texas educators by their support of the supplement and the COLA. These legislators will receive the prestigious PUBLIC EDUCATION CHAMPION AWARD from Raise Your Hand Texas. Of the ten House members and the four senators who have a constituency in TRTA District 6, five House members will receive the award (Ashby, Bailes, Kacal, Orr, and Raney) and one Senator (Nichols). These officials have been consistent in their support of both Texas public schools and personnel and retired Texas educators. We owe them a great measure of thanks for their unfailing support.

BCRSP General Meeting Minutes

BCRSP Monthly Meeting May 24, 2023

Vice President Frances Maloney called the meeting to order at 11:35. Chaplain Betty Munion offered the invocation and led members in the United States and Texas pledges.

We were introduced to two of our scholarship recipients: Anthony Vasquez from CSISD and Jose Ramirez from BISD.

Program: CASA: Voices for Children was presented to us by Nancy Browning. The CASA program was introduced to Texas in 1989. There are 73 programs in the State of Texas. 5 counties being served in the Brazos Valley - Brazos, Burleson, Grimes, Madison and Leon. During COVID they served 574 children. In 2022- 432 children were served and present 142.

Legislative: James Warner gave us an update on the Senate proposal to pass the HJR2 Bill. This will include our COLA and a supplement check for retirees. Final action is to take place May 29.

Other Business: Our Book Committee-Carolyn Parsons and Sandy Petty- reported that they have purchased 360 books and will begin distributing them. If you know of any organizations that need books for needy children, please let them know.

Max Thompson thanked everyone who voted for him for the TRS Board of Trustee Election. Max and one other person are on the ballot for consideration. The Governor will decide who will be on the board.

Vice President Francis Maloney adjourned the meeting at 1:20.
